Tribal Profile

- Descendants of the Plains and Sierra Miwok who lived and prospered in the Sacramento Valley
- 1958 Rancheria Act terminated federal trusts; Congress ratified the termination in 1964
- Federal recognition lost in 1964, restored in 2009
- Over **700** members currently
- Over 62% live in South Sacramento County
- 40% of members under 18
- 60% of tribal youth reside in Elk Grove Unified School District
- Long-term effects of termination: poverty, health, & social problems
- **62%** unemployment rate (U.S. average: 6.3%)
- Median annual income \$20,000 (U.S. poverty line for family of four: \$24,000/yr.)
- **38%** without health insurance (U.S. average: 10.4%)
- College graduation rate 14% (U.S. average: 34%)
